



Finding Magazine, Newspaper & Journal Articles

Use an Electronic Resource to Find Articles on Your Topic

1. Go to the Library home page: <http://library.aucegypt.edu/>
2. Click on the link entitled, “**Find Articles.**”
3. You can choose a resource by name if you know the name of the database you require, or you can select a subject area that applies to your particular research needs in the **By Major** section.

NOTE: Reference staff can provide assistance in the selection of a database. Some useful resources for a variety of disciplines include the following:

Academic Search Complete (EBSCOhost)	◆ Multi-subject database of magazine, newspaper and scholarly journal articles. [Full Text]
JSTOR	◆ Multi-subject database of retrospective scholarly journal articles. [Full Text]
Project Muse	◆ Multi-subject database of recent scholarly journal articles. [Full Text]
Global Newsbank	◆ Articles from a variety of global news sources. [Full Text]
LEXIS-NEXIS Academic Universe	◆ Articles from major newspapers. [Full Text]
ZAD/Arshif Al-Suhufi...	◆ Articles in Arabic from more than 700 Arabic newspapers and magazines. [Full Text]

4. Be sure to print or copy the citation for any articles that you use including the name of the magazine, newspaper or journal, volume number, issue number, date and pages.

5. Click on the link to **HTML** full text or **PDF** full text *if available* to view and print, e-mail or download your article. If the full text is not available in this database follow the remaining steps to locate your article.

Find the Full Text Article in Another Database

These next steps will help you to locate articles that are *not* available full text in the database you initially chose for your research.

1. Go to the Library home page: <http://library.aucegypt.edu/>
2. In the box entitled, "**Library Catalog**," you will find a link for the "**E-Journal Finder**." Click on this link.
3. Enter a few distinctive words from the **TITLE** of your magazine, newspaper or journal to search.
4. If your title appears and the database covers your year, follow the link to retrieve the full text of articles for the date ranges listed.

Paper and Microform Articles

The Library subscribes to many magazines, newspapers and journals in print. Older issues for many titles are held in the periodicals and microforms department on the Ground Floor Periodicals/Wallace Annex.

To see if the Library has a paper or microfilm copy of your article, consult the **Library Catalog**.

1. Do a search by title by selecting "**Periodical Title**" from the drop-down menu in the **Library Catalog** search box.
2. Enter the title of the periodical you require in the box to the right of the drop-down menu and click **Search**.
3. View the full record to see the list of volumes and/or years held by the Library.

Articles that the Library Does Not Own

If you need a book or journal that the Library does not own, we can help. Complete a document request form available on the Library's website.

2. Click on the link entitled, "**Request Documents**."
